## **QUESTIONS & DISCUSSION**

Q 01 Have you ever had a nickname? Who gave it to you, and what's the story behind it?

Your behaviors are a reflection of your identity. What you do is an indication of the type of person you believe that you are." - James Clear, Atomic Habits

Q 02 Do you have any behaviors or personality traits that have become part of your identity? How do they shape the way you see yourself and interact with the world around you?

Q 03 If you had to introduce yourself in light of your new identity in Christ (instead of your past struggles), how would you do it? ("Hi, my name is \_\_\_\_\_, and I am... (alive with Christ!, adopted into God's family, loved by God, etc.")

Q 04 Paul anticipates the question, "Shall we go on sinning so that grace may increase?" Have you ever struggled with this concept? How might someone misunderstand God's grace in this way, and what are the risks of that thinking?

Q 05 Jason told us on Sunday about the elephant with the stake in the ground. In what areas of your life do you struggle to believe that you are truly set free from sin? How can we encourage one another to walk in freedom?
